St Andrews Player Code of Conduct

By signing your registration form and agreeing to play with St Andrews Cricket Club this season, you have also agreed to abide by the Club's Code of Conduct, whether at training, games, official functions or other occasions representing the Club.

All players of St Andrews Cricket Club must abide by Cricket Australia's rules and policies applying to players.

As well, all members of St Andrews Cricket Club must:

- Abide by the rules of the Victorian Cricket Association.
- Not argue with officials, Any disputes or complaints may only be addressed through coach and captains and addressed via official Club channels.
- Display self-control at all times. Verbal abuse of officials, other players, or deliberately distracting or provoking a competitor is neither acceptable nor condoned.
- Work equally hard for yourself and your team.
- Recognise all good performances whether or not they are by your team members or others.
- Treat all members of the Club as you would like to be treated. Do not interfere with, bully or take advantage of another person.
- No person who is participating in a match under the jurisdiction or auspices of the Cricket Victoria or its affiliates shall engage in any conduct, act towards or speak to any other person in a manner which offends, insults, humiliates or vilifies such person on the basis of that person's race, religion, colour, descent or ethnic origin.
- Co-operate with coach, captains, team mates and others.
- Be ready to start training at the appointed time. If unavailable or late for training, players are required to notify coach as early as possible. Coach and Captain numbers will be handed to all players at start of the season.
- Be appropriately dressed for training and for games.
- Not consume alcohol during games or training or present to play or train in an intoxicated state.
- Inform coaching staff or selection committee if you are unavailable to a play prior to the scheduled game.
- Pay all fees and subs by the due date. Failure to do so will result in players not being available for selection.
- Carry out reasonable instructions from coach, captains or Committee.
- Approach training as if it was a match. Bat, Bowl & Field to the best of your ability
- Not smoke in changing rooms, club rooms, training venues or field of play. Smoking is restricted to designated areas.
- Players are encouraged to have a drink and friendly chat with the opposition after a match, either home or away, but should also make every effort to return to the clubrooms in time for the after-match presentations
- Conduct themselves at ALL TIMES in a manner that would bring credit to the Club, especially when wearing Club uniform or other identification.

Any misconduct will be dealt with by the St Andrews Committee.
